



Bunn Leisure's Dog Policy

Bunn Leisure is proud to be a pet friendly family holiday park which adds to your home-from-home experience. Dogs are welcome onto all our parks however, for the comfort and well-being of all persons, the following rules need to be followed. If the following rules are not complied with, the dog will be removed from park.

Dogs Barred From Park

The following dogs are not permitted on Park under any circumstances:

- Pit Bull Terriers
- Japanese Tosa
- Dogo Argentino
- Fila Brasileiro

General

- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and wear a collar with an identity tag.
- Owners must hold dog insurance with liability cover. (approximately £20pa on a household policy)
- Dogs must be under the control of a competent and capable person.
- Dogs may be exercised **on a lead** in the following dog walking areas: Archery Field (W.Sands), Saltings (W.Sands), and White Horse Recreation Field.

Owners must pick up after their dogs. There are numerous dog bins located at all access points for this purpose.

Dogs in Facility Buildings

With the exception of guide dogs, dogs cannot enter clubs, restaurants, arcades, shops or leisure areas.

Well behaved dogs are welcome in the following venues:

- The Ocean Bar
- JB's Sports Bar: **Ground floor only**
- The Viking Bar Area

Dogs in Caravans

- If your dog is prone to barking it must not be left unattended.
- The caravan must be adequately ventilated & there must not be a welfare concern for the dog.

Dogs Tethered Outside Caravans

- The dog must be on a secure lead no greater than 3 metres in length.
- The lead is to be fixed adjacent to the middle of the door side of the caravan.
- The dog must be under supervision - If left unattended the dog must have a muzzle on.
- It must not represent a threat or cause a noise concern to neighbours or passers-by.
- There must not be a welfare concern for the dog.

Dogs Tethered Outside Buildings

- Dogs must be tethered on a short lead so is not to cause a nuisance to passers-by, a trip hazard or block the door.
- If left unattended the dog must have a muzzle on.
- The dog must be left only for the minimal time necessary.
